PHOENIX FAUCETS, AVON LAKE

Three additional employees needed the classroom instruction and driving test. All of the employees successfully completed the program.

U.S. STEEL, LORAIN

On July 11th through July 15th the Adult Career Center conducted 40-hours of welding training to the plant craft employees at U.S. Steel. This training up-graded their welding skills to a 6G pipe standard. A 6G standard in pipe is one of the more demanding of the welding standards. The training was arranged by Russ Beach, Program Developer and Mario Mendes of U.S. Steel. Instructor Alex Stoll conducted the training, in which all participating student showed considerable improvement in their skill levels.
