#### Evening Child Care for Adult JVS Students

The Lorain County JVS Adult Career Center is working with The Child Garden of Oberlin (located across the street on RT 58) to offer evening child care for our students. The facility needs a minimum of 8 students enrolled in order to offer evening child care. The center does accept child care vouchers from the Lorain County Department of Job & Family Services. If students have their children enrolled at another Child Garden location (LaGrange or Grafton) they can transfer enrollment to Oberlin for FREE.

### **Firelands Health and Wellness Fair**

The Lorain County JVS Adult Career Center will be participating in the Firelands School District's second annual Health and Wellness Fair on Wednesday, October 27<sup>th</sup> from 3:00-6:00 p.m. at Firelands High School. The fair will be open to employees and community members. The Adult Career Center will present information on all facets of healthy living and courses we offer for adults interested in related careers.

## ***ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT***

### **Adult Career Center to Partner in Connect Your Community (CYC) Initiative**

Connect Your Community is a unique computer training program for economic and social advancement in Lorain County. The CYC program offers free computer training, tech- support, and subsidized high-speed Internet service (where available) for eligible households in Lorain County. The program is open to all Lorain County residents and is funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act.

The CYC project empowers residents to advance careers, expand educational horizons, connect with colleagues, family, and friends, and access better health care and government services. Classes will be available at the Lorain County JVS Adult Career and throughout the county, with courses that will include:

- The Basics of Computers and the Internet
- Computer Skills for Career Advancement
- How to Find a Job Online
- An Entrepreneur's Guide to the Internet
- Arts, Culture, and Education Online

### **United Way, Lorain**

Diana Gott, Program Developer, contracted with United Way in Lorain to upgrade their employees' computer skills from Office 2003 to Office 2007. Topics included Word, Excel and Outlook. The three- hour training session was held at the JVS.

### **Ridge Tool, Elyria**

Diana Gott, Program Developer and Assessment Coordinator, contracted with Ridge Tool for computer training and assessment testing.

JVS computer instructor, Peggy Hastings, will upgrade the computer skills of approximately 40 Ridge Tool employees from Office 2003 to Office 2010. Training will include Windows 7, Microsoft Office and also the use of a variety of media applications.

A 3-hour Assembly assessment was conducted for 3 Ridge Tool employees. This assessment will screen for an internal job posting.

### **Parker-Hannifin, Elyria**

Russ Beach, Program Developer, coordinated a 20-hour OSHA class for Parker Hannifin. The training consisted of a review of OSHA Standard 1910-178, a hands-on evaluation of the employee's ability to drive a lift truck and a written exam. Sixteen employees participated in the training and all successfully completed the program.
