MEDICATION POLICY & PROCEDURE

An IMPORTANT REMINDER to parents/guardians regarding the Medical Policy for the Lorain County JVS:

- A completed Administration of Medication Form **MUST** accompany ALL medications before they can be administered. Prescription medications require **both** a physician and parent signature. Over the counter (OTC) medications require only a parent signature. (**Note: If requesting a dose higher than the recommended dose for OTC medications, a physician's signature IS required. If no physician signature, only the recommended dose will be given.*)
- Medication forms can be downloaded from the school website or obtained from the school clinic.
- All medication must be brought to the school by a parent or responsible adult. Medications **cannot** be transported to school on the bus.
- All medication must be in its original container with its original label.
- **Self-carry medications:** By state law, the only medications a student is permitted to carry are EpiPens, inhalers and/or diabetic supplies. A completed Medication Form is still required and a back-up EpiPen must still be supplied to the school clinic.

HealthCare Action Plans and/or Administration of Medication Forms will be sent home with all students with health conditions who may require treatment at school. Please be sure both parent and physician signatures are included on the form(s).
