



Student - In - Need Grant Application

In order to assist students of families experiencing heavy financial responsibilities, the Lorain County JVS Educational Foundation is making monies available to assist in the payment of a portion of your student's fees. To be considered for fee assistance, please complete this application and provide a copy of last year's income tax return, proof of disability, or other proof of income. Your proof of hardship must be attached to this application or it will not be considered.

Funding requests are reviewed approximately one week before the end of each grading period. Requests from senior students are given priority. Due to limited funds, not all requests can be funded. Those requests awarded will be limited to 80% of the student fees.

At the time application is submitted, it is requested that at least 20% of the student fees be paid.

PLEASE NOTE:

At this time, grant requests will not be accepted from Freshman and Sophomore students. Applications for Junior students will not be considered until the Second Semester of the Junior Year and only after your 20% portion has been paid. Senior students may apply at any time as long as their 20% portion has been paid as well.
